


# **Adrenal incidentaloma.** Current situation in Lithuania

#### **Conclusions.**


1. From 2007 to 2011 cases of adrenal tumors increased twice.

compounds are benign adrenal adenomas. We attempted to find out the current situation of adrenal incidentaloma in Lithuania.




### Referral diagnosis





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
